Below are some of the sessions offered by Government Support Services:

Procurement Basics:

During this session we will cover the basics of Delaware procurement regulations and practices. Participants will learn how to navigate **My Marketplace**, identify central contracts, apply Delaware Code in all procurements, the Small Purchase Thresholds and Procedures for those purchases not available through the central contracts, and what to consider from a supplier diversity standpoint.

•Help Me (Formal Procurements – User Group, Resources, Outreach):

This session will breakdown the procurement process - what is the role of the user group; what are the resources available online; and how to maximize your vendor outreach.

•Ready, Set, Bid (Formal Procurements – Live Bid, Evaluation, Award):

This session will breakdown the procurement process - a closer look at the live bid and what to expect; bid evaluation process and understanding who is responsible for what; basics regarding the contract award.

•Contract Management: This session provides an overview of contract management, after the award. Topics include: contract file, extensions, CPI-U, performance issues, and My Marketplace updates.
